



## 2009 Community Grant Awards

The A.C.N.M. Foundation Community Grant Awards support community projects that promote excellence in health care for women, infants and families worldwide. This award is ideal for midwives caring for underserved populations, community activists and retired midwives. Projects must be able to document need and have the ability to evaluate (quantitatively or qualitatively) impact on a community level. All funds must be used to directly benefit the community (i.e., patient education materials, supplies, equipment); funds may not be used for professional support (i.e., dues, licenses or professional education).

**Deadline** March 13, 2009

**Award Amount:** Not to exceed \$500.00 per project

**Award Announcement** Awards will be announced at the Awards Ceremony at the A.C.N.M. Annual Meeting, on Friday May 22, 2009.

**Project Implementation Dates:** Projects may begin anytime after the announcement date, and should be completed by December 31, 2009. A final report should be submitted to the A.C.N.M. Foundation by February 28, 2010.

### Application Procedure:

2. Project Description (500 words or less)
  - Project description
  - Time line of anticipated start and completion
  - Document community need
  - Budget
  - Method of evaluation
3. Letter of support (Optional)

Applications **MUST** be received (by email or postmarked) by March 13, 2009 to be eligible for consideration.
